

# PROJECT PATTERN ROUND ZIPPER COIN PURSE

Paper Size: US Letter

Paper Size: A4  
210 by 297 mm

Orientation: Portrait Landscape

Scale: 100%

## Printing Instruction

The pattern is designed to be printable. We took into consideration the standard printer margin for letter & A4 sized papers.

Select "US letter" or "A4" under paper size. Make sure portrait mode is selected.

Be sure to click "scale: 100%" to ensure that the page is going to print to scale.

## Recommended Materials

1. 9153-16 #2 Low-Grade Burnishable Colored Veg Tanned Sides, 2.0mm~2.4mm (5/6oz)
2. 9404-12 Soft Suede Pigskin Splits

## Instruction

1. Trace the pattern and mark the hole positions onto the leather and lining. Rough cut them.
2. Apply the Diamond Leather Finish to the front of the leather using the Round Leathercraft Sponge. Once dry, cut the leather and lining along the outline.
3. Use the French Edge Skiver to thin out the body and tab.
4. Bevel the edges and burnish them with a wooden slicker. Use the Wing Divider to mark stitching line positions with a 3mm wide guideline.
5. Use a 2mm Diamond Stitching Chisel and a Round Drive Punch to punch holes in the body and tab. Punch holes in the lining according to the marking points.
6. Cut the zipper to a length of about 25cm (10"), and mark points about 1cm (3/8") from the end. Apply glue to the edge of the zipper tape.
7. Use the Wing Divider to mark a 6.5mm (1/4") wide zipper attachment position on the back of the body, and mark the alignment points at the end of the zipper. Apply glue between the stitching holes and the lines.
8. Split the zipper apart, align the marks, and glue it along the edge of the body. You can use a Scratch Awl to help evenly distribute the folds of the zipper tape.
9. Install the zipper slider and verify if the front and back body pieces are aligned. Cut the zipper teeth to the correct length.
10. Install the zipper stop with the Jewelry Pliers.
11. Smooth out the folds of the zipper tape at the bends of the body.
12. Insert the tab into the snap, align the holes on the body, and secure with the rivets.
13. Apply glue along the inside of the stitching holes on the back of the lining and the body. Align the center points using Positioning Needles, then glue together.
14. Stitch the body, zipper, and lining together to complete the project.

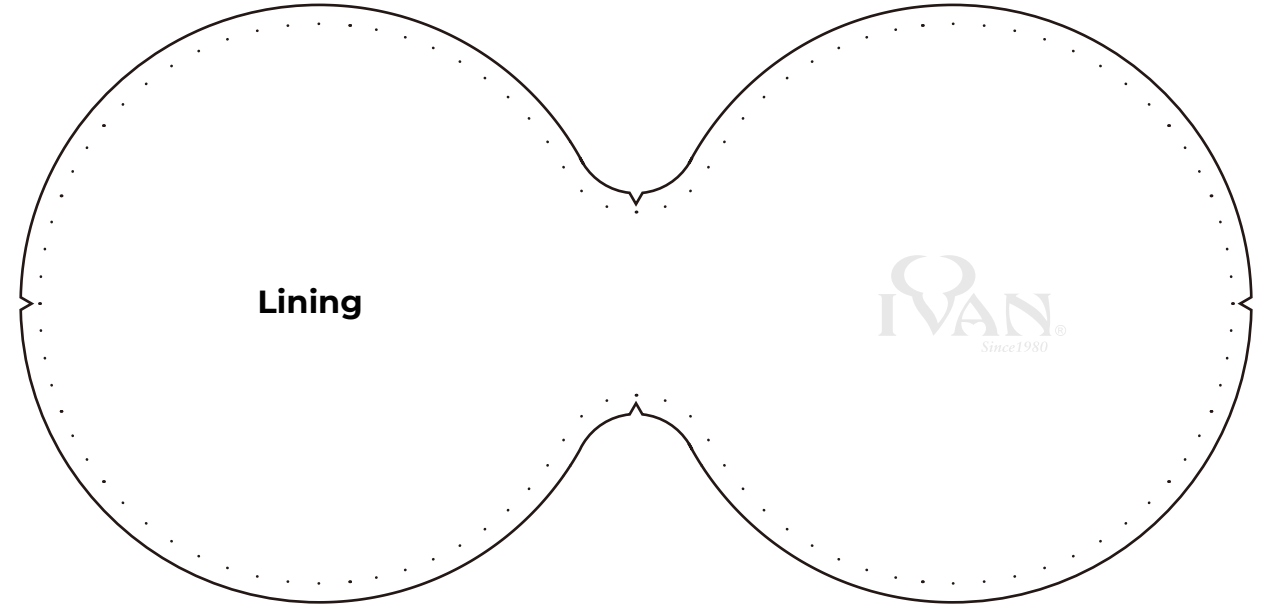
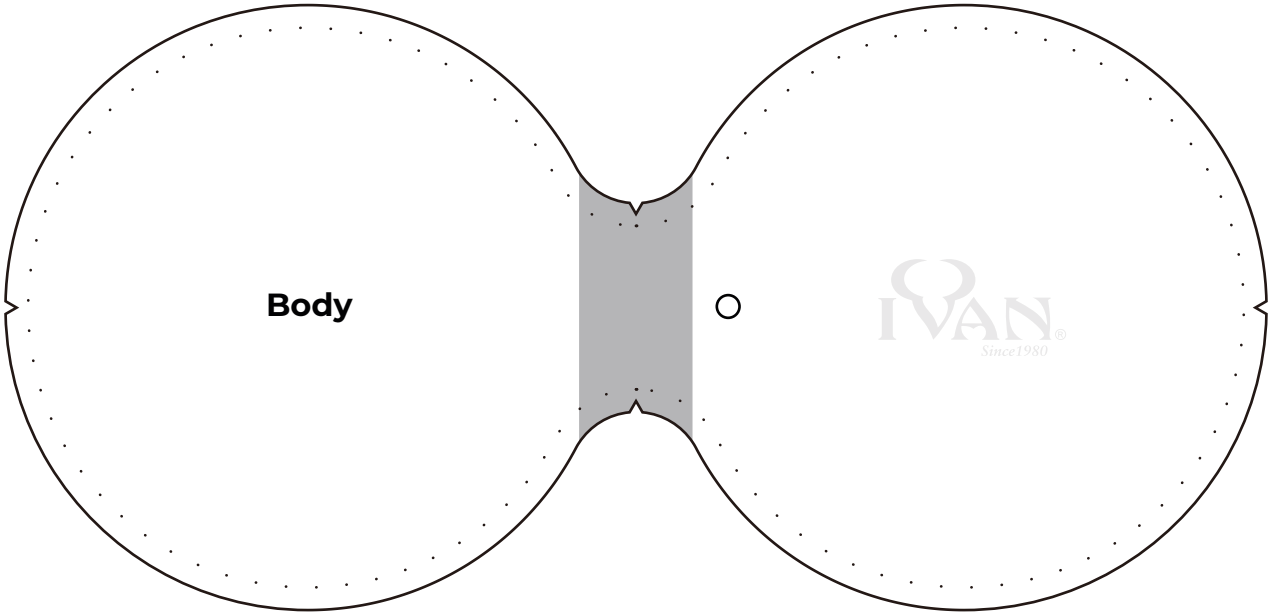

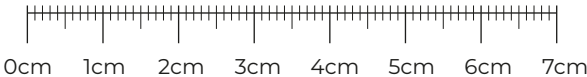
