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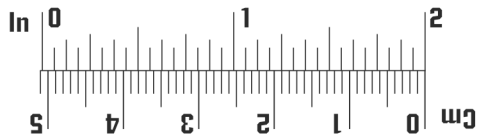

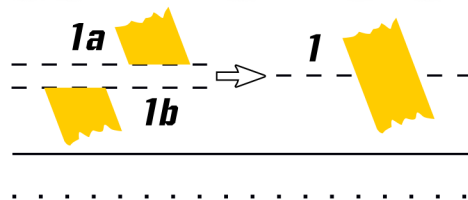

* You will also require six 20 mm buckles, 1 magnetic clasp, 2 snap fasteners, 3 head ball studs and 23 rivets.

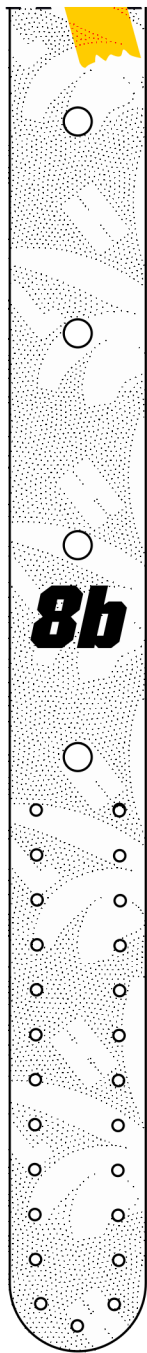

The straps length needs to be adjusted to your own size and that will mean fastening them around your waist at their full size and trimming off the excess length just like you would do with a regular belt.

****Make sure they're quite centered around parts 7 and 10 before proceeding to cut them.***

****Leave two extra holes if you can so they can be fastened on the head ball studs. The head ball studs work as belt loop keepers.***

****Add to the straps length if you have a larger waist size.***
