

# Slipper booties "Tammy"

Model 322-37

Sizes 36/37 up to 40/41



## PRINT THE CUT

1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter). (Do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!) )
2. Check the square – if it is 10×10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size. (The overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet.)

**Important:** Instructions do not include seam allowances, unless otherwise indicated!

## SUPPLIES

- 0.3 m reversible plush, 147 cm wide
- Remnant leather, not too thick
- Remnant of decorative ribbon, 2–2.5 cm wide
- Remnant of cotton fabric
- Style-Vil (Vlieseline)

## CUTTING

- 1 2× shaft on the fold
- 2 2× foot part on the fold
- 3 2× sole (leather)
- 4 2× inner sole (outer fabric)

Cut the inner sole also from cotton fabric and Style-Vil.

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Close the rear centre seam on the shaft. Separate the allowances and finish the top edge. Place the ribbon centrally over the seam and topstitch it on both sides. The lower end of the ribbon should end approx. 5 mm in front of the seam line to the sole.
2. Sew in foot part from marking "heart" to "star". Place the allowances towards the shaft and topstitch them. Finish the lower edge. Gather the rounding of the foot part, pushing the largest extra length together in the toe area. Sew in the leather sole according to the markings, making sure that the rough leather side is on the outside. Turn the booties inside out, fold over the sole seam, and knock the leather side flat all around with a hammer. If necessary, use fabric staples to fix the leather side and let it rest overnight.
3. Place the plush and the cotton sole right side on right side together and lay Style-Vil on top. Sew the layers together all around, leaving a large opening on one straight section. Cut back the allowances of the Style-Vil considerably. Turn the inner sole inside out. Pin the allowances on top of each other and topstitch the sole all around. Insert the inner soles. Fold the shaft over twice.



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
