- **0.8MM WAXED THREAD**
- **ACRYLIC / PLASTIC / OTHER MATERIAL**
- **STEEL WIRE**
- **25MM BUCKLE**

- **SHARP KNIFE**
- **1.2 - 1.5 MM HOLE PUNCHER / PRICKING IRONS OR AWL**
- **HAMMER**
- **2 NEEDLES**
- **PAPER TAPE**
- **A HOME PRINTER**
