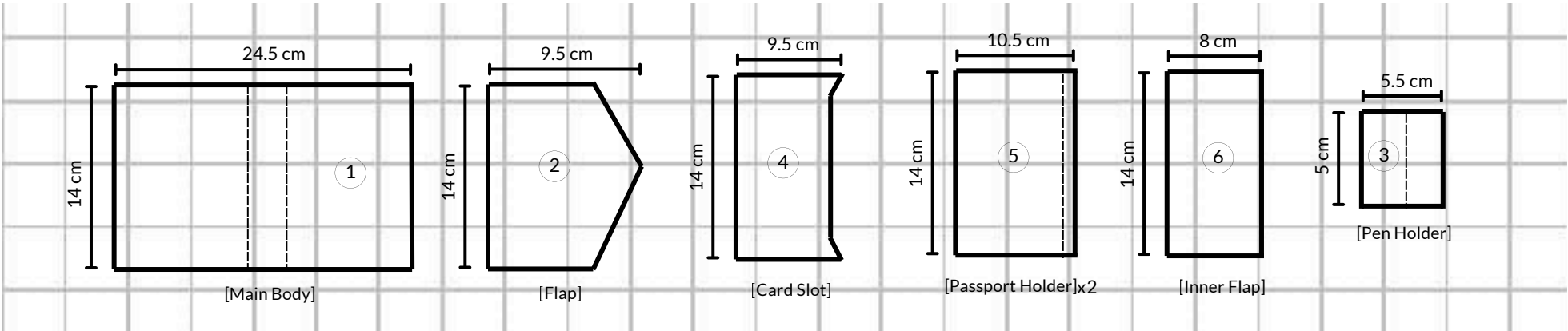
## DIMENSION :

- Main Body ( L24.5 × W 14 cm )
- Flap( L 14.5 × W 14 cm )
- Pen Holder ( L 5.5 × W 5 cm )
- Card Slot ( L14 × W9.5 cm )
- Passport Holder ( L14 × W10.5 cm )x2
- Inner Flap ( L14 × W8 cm )



- **Faux Leather :**  
"If you're using faux leather, you'll need approximately 50 x 28 cm of leather."
  - **Natural Leather :**  
"If you're using natural leather, you'll need 1.5square feet of leather."
  - **Polyster Leather/ Waxed Thread :**  
"You'll need approximately 160 centimeters of thread."
- **Plant-based Adhesive :**  
"Plant-based glue provides better adhesion and has less odor, making it more suitable for working in small spaces."
  - **Edge paint :**  
"Apply edge paint to the edges of the bag using a suitable edge painting tool."
  - **Four-Part Button :**  
"Feel free to use a medium magnetic button for this project."

## SEWING TUTORIAL :

---

1-Print the pattern file and cut out the main bag pattern with scissors.

2-Arrange the patterns on the leather with some space between them (for natural leather on the grain side / for synthetic leather on the back side).

3-Trace around the patterns carefully with a gel pen or an awl.

4-Cut along the spaces between the leathers using a sharp cutter blade.

5-Skive the cut pieces with a skiving machine or by hand.

6-Trim the skived leathers again with a cutter so the pen marks are discarded.

7-Cover the button with leather, as explained in the previous tutorial.

8-Glue the inner flap body to the flap, trim excess pieces, and crease the inner and outer edges.

9-Burnish the flap edges, apply edge paint, and stitch.

10-Attach the button onto the flap using a press.

11-Glue and stitch the flap to the main body.

12-Cut the pen holder in half and glue its edge.

13- Fold the two passport slots, crease them, and glue the pen holder onto the edge of one passport slot.

14-Stitch the edges of the passport slots.

15-Crease and edge-paint the card slot edge, then glue it onto the passport slot.

16-Stitch the middle of the cardholder to divide it into two slots.

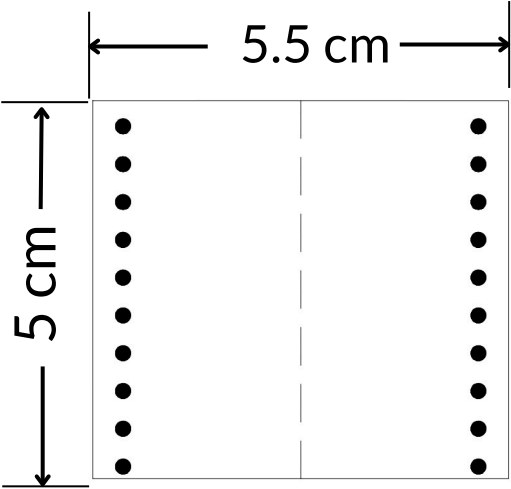
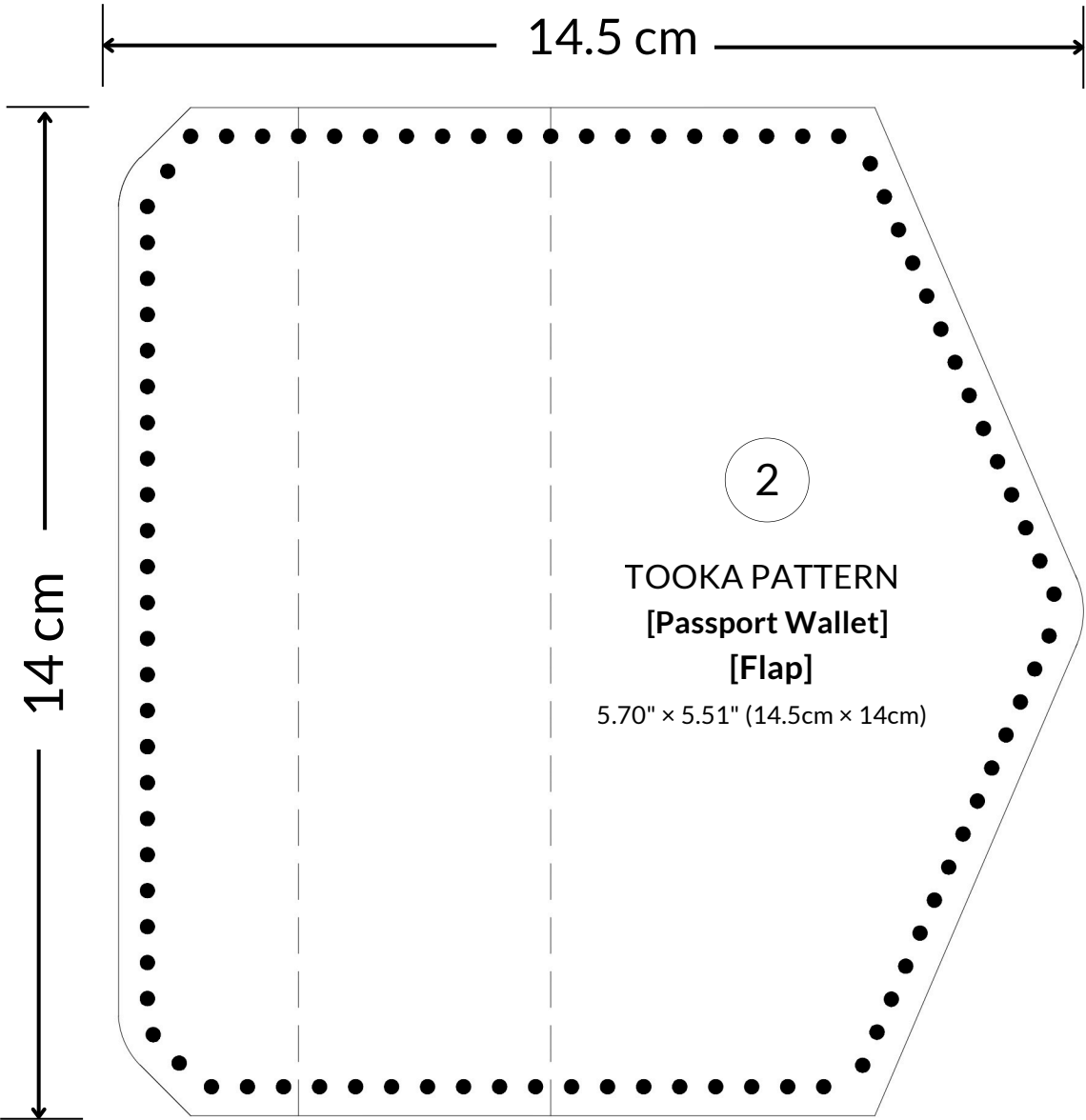
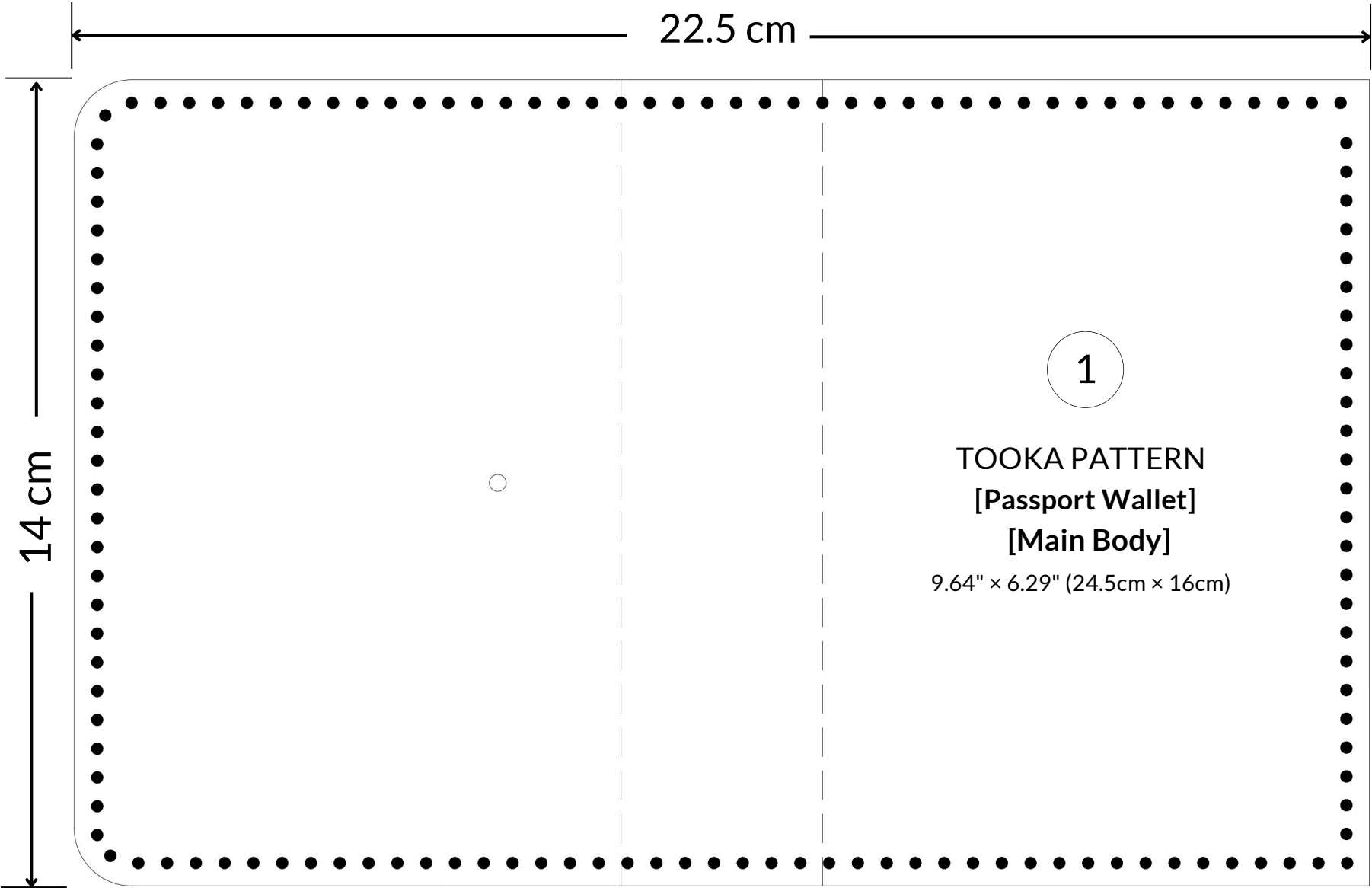
17-Glue the passport slot to the main body and stitch the left edge.

18-Crease, burnish, edge-paint, and stitch all around the inner and outer edges of the wallet.

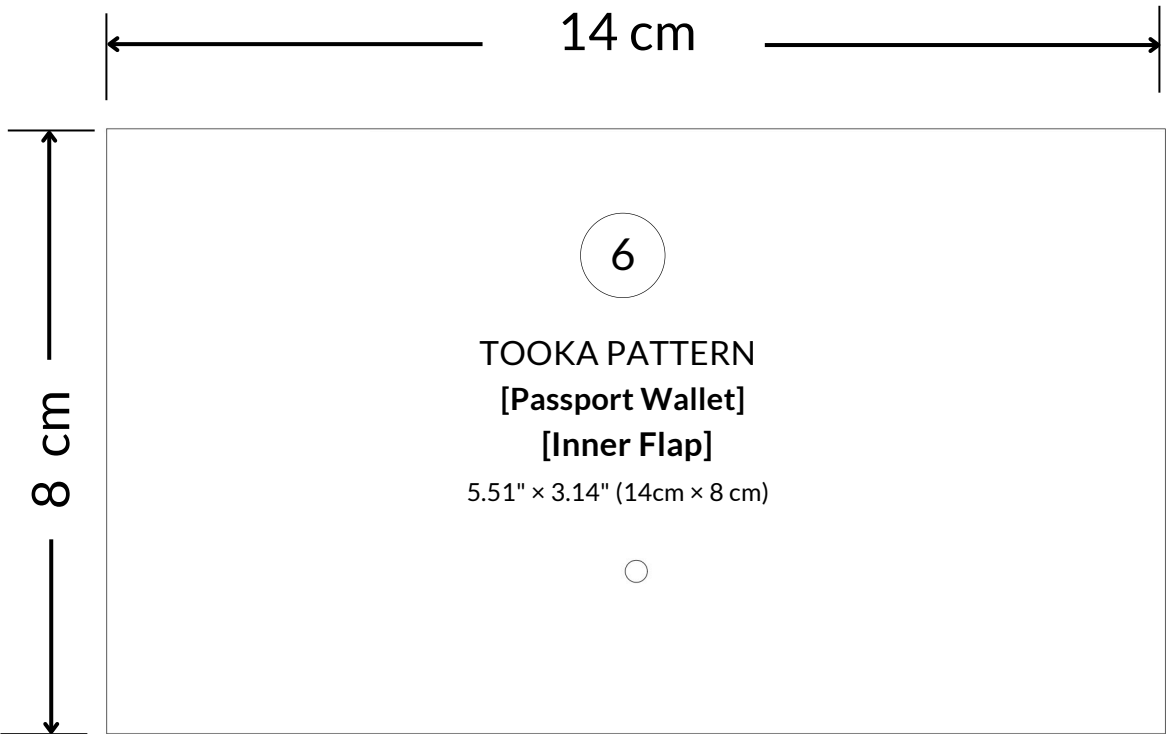
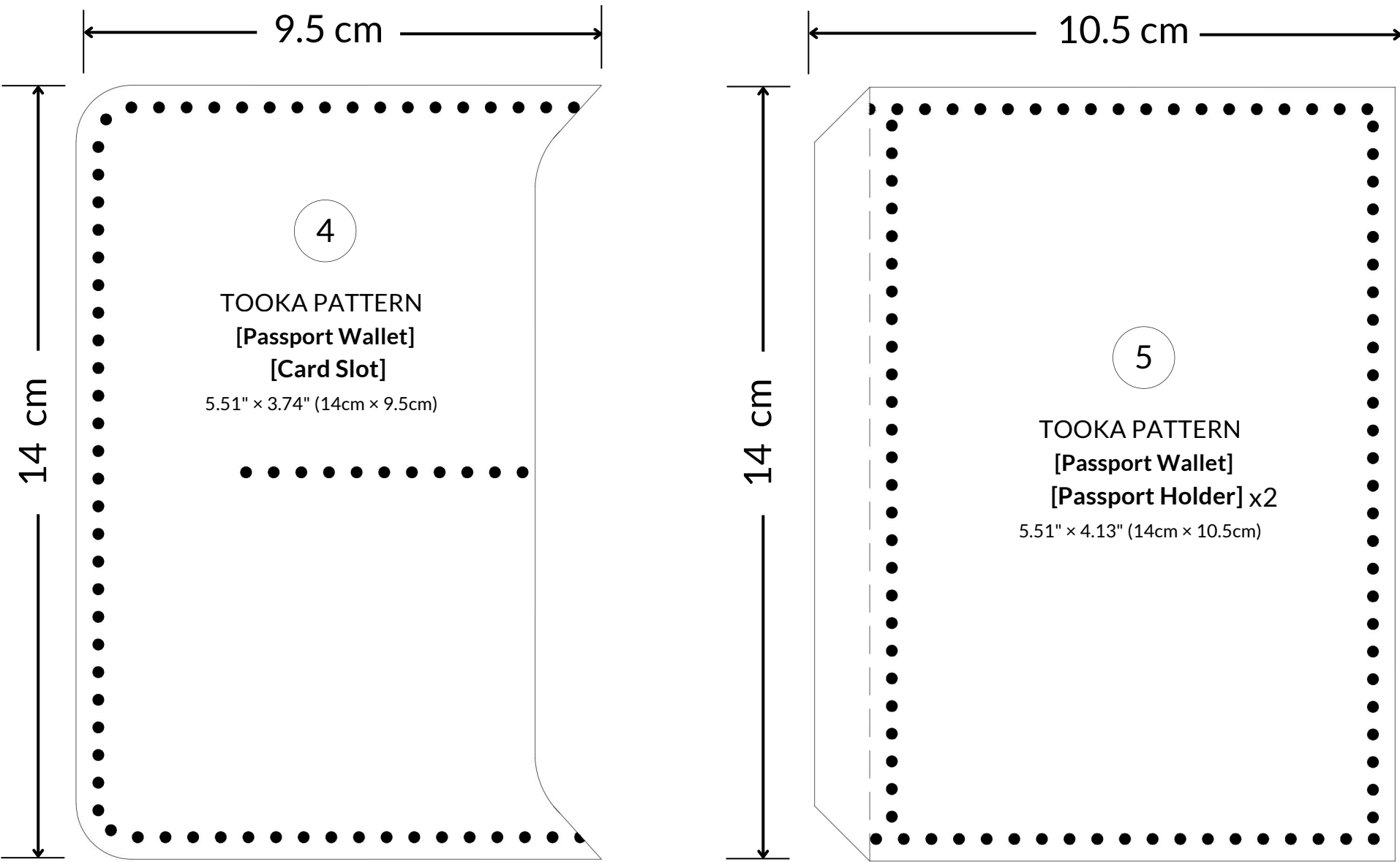
